



St. Paul Lutheran Church Preschool... A Ministry for Families, Outside Our Walls

The SPLC Preschool is a ministry for families outside of our walls. Although the Preschool is located in the church building, the Preschool serves diverse families from all over the New Braunfels area. These families are dual working, single parents, foster families, Christian and not yet Christians.

The ministry goal of this program is planting and watering the seeds of faith with families. The staff and administrators accomplish this through children attending Chapel twice a week with a planned set of Bible teachings, traditional children's faith songs and an in-class planned curriculum for learning about the Bible. As we know, parents are children's first teachers; so it is essential to include teaching families about Jesus. We do this by 1) sending the Chapel curriculum home with activities that families can do together; 2) sharing with families on our private group Facebook page; 3) through experiences for the entire family on Sundays with the congregation such as the Christmas program; 4) teaching families to bless their children at the Blessing the Pre-K Graduate; and 5) monthly planned parent activities in the late afternoon during the week. Each of these activities are opportunities for sharing the Gospel. To bring the program together, we ask families to practice and help the children memorize a monthly Bible verse. We are working toward requiring families to complete Raising a Healthy Preschooler Stepping Stone as part of the enrollment process and we encourage the Preschool families to attend Raising a Healthy Kindergartner at the end of their last year with us.

During the recent closures concerning the global pandemic, the SPLC Preschool remained open to essential personnel, further serving our communities and extending outside our walls to new families. We received State level recognition for being one of the few Preschools to remain open without any closures. The Preschool is still operating under the strictest of guidelines to continue to do all we can to help our community and families stay healthy. Because of these guidelines, the Preschool is not currently sharing any space with the church. This means we cannot share classrooms with the congregation during the week or on Sundays. The Preschool school age summer camp, which is usually located upstairs, has moved down into the downstairs classrooms to provide more space for the church upstairs. It is a critical time in our community to continue to work to keep everyone healthy and do all we can do. We look forward to when we can once again share spaces. We miss sharing our Preschool rooms with the Sunday school teachers! We will be with the Congregation again on Sunday, June 28 for Blessing the Pre-K Graduate. We have many families eager to acknowledge and participate in this big jump from Preschool into Kindergarten. The Preschool families will also participate in our Stepping Stone class, raising a Health Kindergartner in August.

The Preschool staff, children and families would like to thank the SPLC Congregation for all the support, initiative and guidance during these challenging times. We continue to be a ministry of the church and plant the seeds of faith with families as Christ has called us all to do!
